
The new ZR-1 Registry website

Introduction

After several months of redevelopment the new ZR-1 Registry website is now online and available to all members of the registry and other interested individuals. The new website features a complete visual redesign as well as changes to the technology "behind the scenes" to make it more adaptable and easy to change while also allowing a greater level of functionality and integration that was not possible before. Some of the functionality is available immediately, while some will be rolled out over the next few months.

While the site has been redesigned extensively it is still the club's website and all comments and suggestions will be considered. All websites grow and change over time, the new technology allows us to respond to these suggestions more quickly.


The new site home page is laid out in the following way:



Logging in

One of the main differences between the old website and the new one centers around the concept of "Logging In" to the site. Unlike the old site the new one has individual accounts for every member and ex-member. This provides us with the opportunity to integrate a lot more features into the site that are targeted more effectively. Much of the site is still viewable without logging in as per the old site. However, to access members only content and access special member pricing in the integrated store you will need to log in to the site.

Here is the main menu that provides access to the main sections of the site and the login button.



If you have a username and password already, clicking on "Login" brings up a box where you can enter your details to enter the site, like this:

We suggest you check the "Remember Login" option so that you don't have to login every time you visit the site. Note that if you forget your password, you can get it back by clicking on the "Retrieve Password" link.

After logging in you will see a Logout link on the right hand side and also a link with your display name (in this case DaveK). This link gives you access to your profile information and also the ability to add your vehicles to the ZR-1 Registry.

Usernames and Passwords

If you are a current or past ZR-1 Net Registry member an account should have been created for you. This account will be linked to the email address stored in the Registry's files and will also pre-populate any known information about you and your vehicle. Your username will default to being your first and last names with no space in-between. So, if your name is John Smith, your login user name would be "johnsmith" (without the quotes). Your password has also been set to an initial value too: the word "password" (without quotes) followed by your registry number with no space in-between. So, if your registry number is 9999 then your default password would be "password9999". For security reasons, you should change it to something else when you first sign in.

Profile information

If you are a current or ex-member of the ZR-1 Net Registry an account has been created for you based on the email address on file in our records. Accounts created in this way are "pre-filled" with information from your registry records. Although we have done our best to ensure this information is accurate there may be some cases where it needs to be updated. To access your profile click on the display name link at the top of the screen. (in this case "DaveK".



This will bring up the member profile page similar to this:



The screen is in three parts. The top section shows your basic profile and contact information and a photo representing you (if you've uploaded one). The middle section displays any cars that you have added or are in the registry records as belonging to you. At the bottom is basic information on you held in the ZR-1 Net Registry records – registry information is not editable directly, if there are any mistakes please contact the membership director, George Jones through membership@zr1netregistry.com (note that the Registry information panel will only be displayed if you are a current member of the ZR-1 Net Registry).

You can change your profile information by clicking on the "Edit Profile" button. This will bring up a page with three tabs on it, like this:



The first tab "User Credentials" displays your basic account information and allows you to change it. Your user name (used for logging in) is fixed, but you can change your Display Name and email address freely. The Display Name is like your nickname on the registry forum and will be what other people will see when using the new site features. Note that if you change the information here it is not applied until you click the "Update" button. Also if you change your name you may make it difficult for the Registry to provide special member features in the future.

The next tab allows you to change your password. Your password should be memorable and known only to you. Your password should be changed from the default when you first login and after that can be changed at any time you wish.

Note that password changes will not be applied until you click the "Change Password" button.

The information entered here is considered confidential and is not available publicly.







Clicking on the article name or "Read More" link will open up the full article, like this:



Another new section is the My Vehicles section mentioned earlier. This section allows you to add, modify and delete ZR-1s that you own so that they will be viewable through the Registry. If the Registry already has information on vehicles you own they should appear in this area by default, like this:



Clicking the "Details" link will show a more detailed set of information for the vehicle, like this:



Clicking on the "Edit" link allows you to edit the car record, like this:
